

Materials Included:

Paper hole reinforcers

Additional household materials:

- Blue food coloring
- Water
- Paper towels
- Flashlight (optional)
- Magnifying glass (optional)

Supertaster Test

Count the number of Papillae on your tongue to determine if you are a supertaster.

- 1. Place a drop of blue food coloring on your tongue.
- 2. Take a sip of water, swish it around in your mouth and spit it out.
- 3. Use a paper towel to dry your tongue as much as possible.
- 4. Place a paper hole reinforcer on the tip of your tongue.
- 5. The dye will stain all of the tongue, except the papillae. The papillae will look like lighter blue or pink bumps in a sea of dark blue.
- 6. Using a flashlight and a magnifying glass if necessary, count the number of papillae within the paper-hole reinforcer. Do not count the really tiny bumps; just count the larger ones.
- 7. Remove the paper-hole reinforcer from your tongue, and write down your number. Use the chart below to determine if you are a non-taster, average taster, or super taster.

15 or fewer papillae	Non-taster
15-30 papillae	Average taster
More than 30 papillae	Super taster
