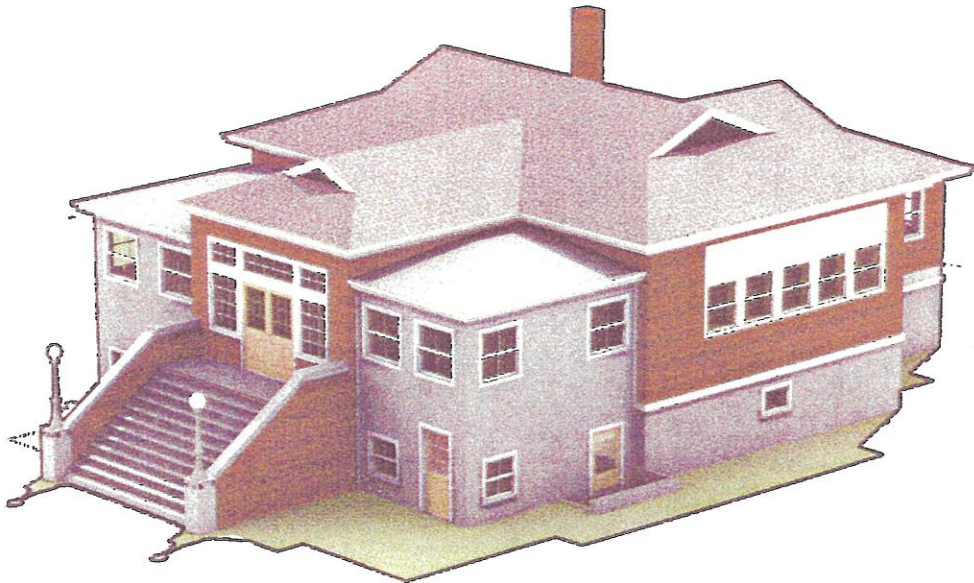

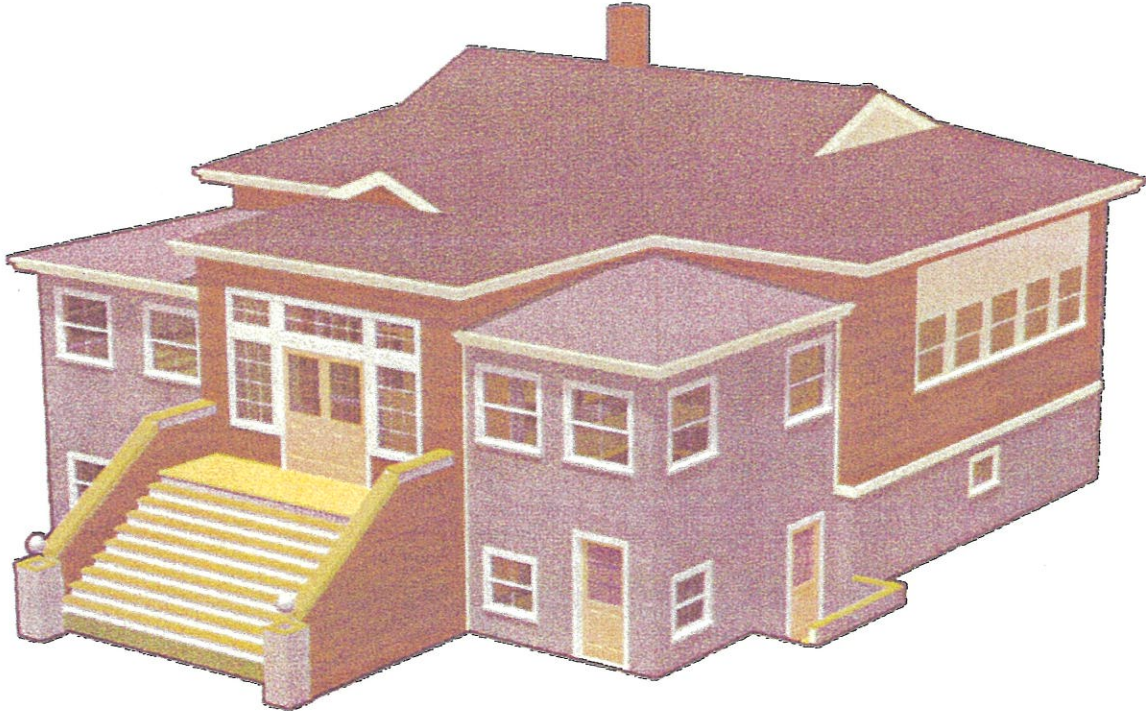
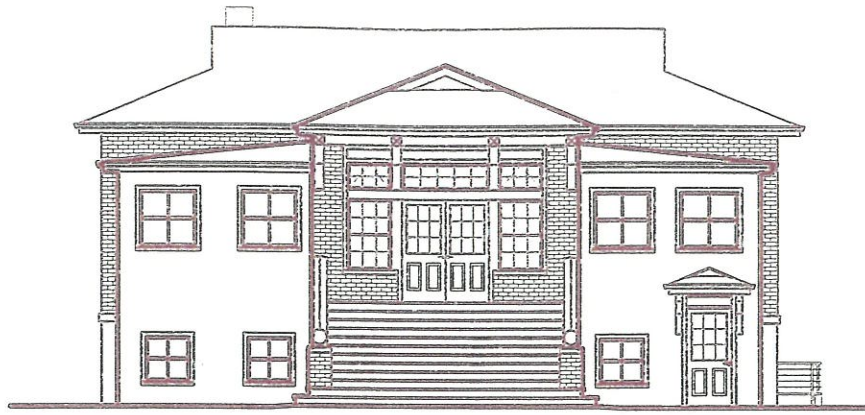
PROPOSED AXONOMETRICS

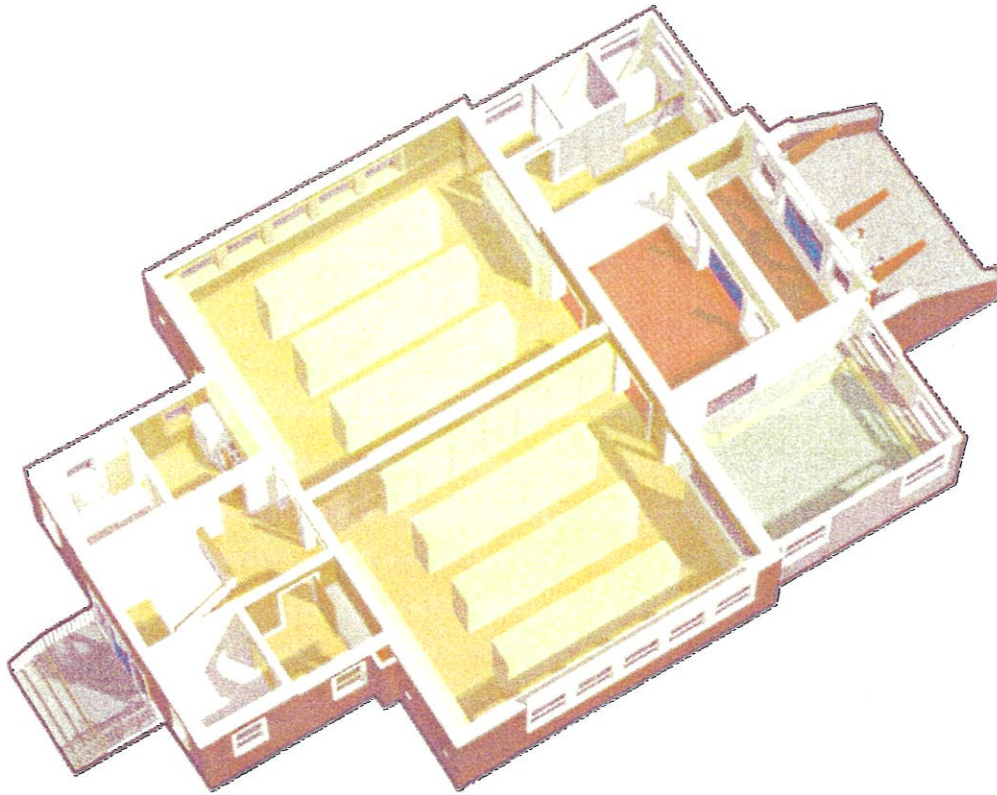

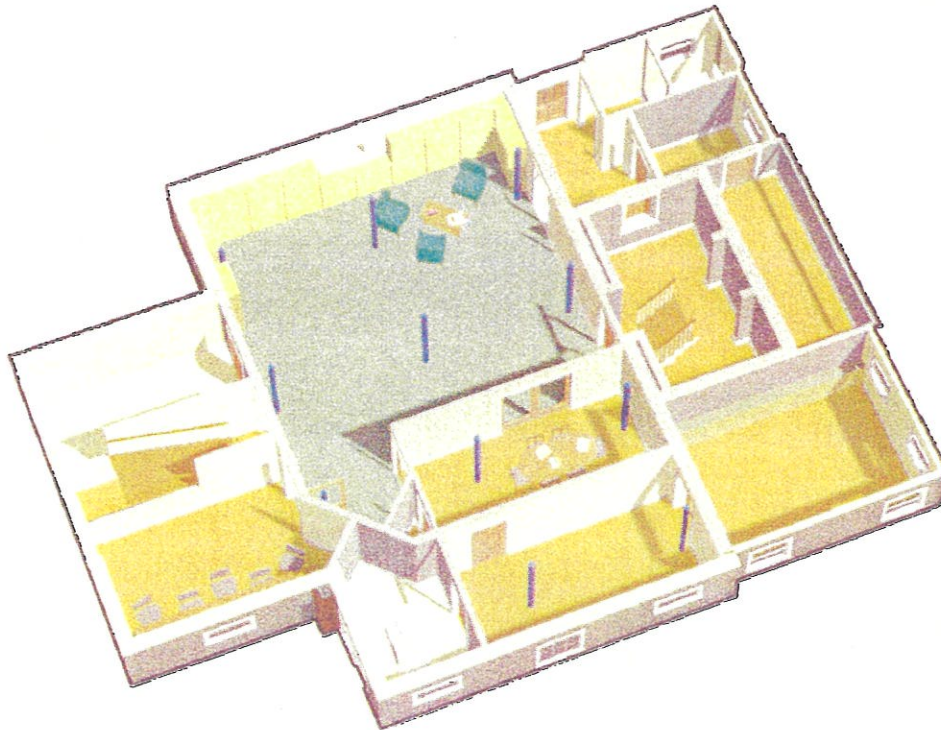

Case for the Lansing Community Library Center Capital Campaign

The need to expand

The Lansing Community Library Center (LCLC) needs to renovate and expand the current facility so that it can accommodate the growth in services required by its many hundreds of patrons.

Where we are today

LCLC has experienced wonderful support from the community, which each year gives generously to fund library operations. Along with hundreds of volunteer hours donated by Lansing residents, community gifts have provided over \$200,000 to support LCLC's operations since the library first opened in 2001.

What LCLC needs

A "quiet phase" of fund raising among business and community leaders has been completed.

- This effort has already raised \$300,000 towards a goal of \$350,000.
- An additional \$50,000 needs to be raised from the community.
- The community part of the Capital Campaign will officially kick off at Twilight Magic, LCLC's annual community celebration and fund raising event. On September 4th the Capital Campaign will be taken to Lansing residents to raise the remaining \$50,000.

How do we get there?

We have attracted funding through naming opportunities for spaces that will be added to the LCLC renovation. We now seek your help to establish endowments that will help the library grow.
